CARAVAN PARK - TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF HIRE

Please ensure that you have read these terms and conditions carefully and check that the details of your booking are complete and accurate, before you sign and/or submit the booking.

Whilst this list of terms and conditions may appear exhaustive, it is important to us that we ensure the hall, and its caravan park are not exposed to any damage. The site should be left in a clean and tidy condition, as found at the commencement of the booking.

It is important that in advance of making a booking you understand that your booking is for the provision of a pitch only, there are no electric hookups for caravans.

Administration

1. All correspondence relating to the hiring must be conducted with the Hall Booking Secretary or other authorised person.
2. Should any dispute regarding a hire occur, this shall be settled by the Hall Committee, whose decision is final and binding.
3. The Hall Committee reserve the right to amend the Contract of Hire, Conditions of Use and Schedule of Charges at any time. We will notify you as soon as reasonably possible. If we amend or cancel your booking, we will transfer your deposit to another booking or refund it to you however, compensation payments will not be payable to you in any circumstances.
4. The Hall Committee reserve the right to refuse admission to or remove from the Hall and Caravan Park any person(s) deemed to be causing a risk/harm to the building, park or its occupant.

Health & Safety

1. Hirers need to be aware that there is no telephone at the Hall and limited mobile reception in the area. Wi-Fi is available at the Hall.

3. Door codes will be given for showers and toilets as part of the booking.
4. Please only use proprietary portable barbecues and ensure they're raised off the ground sufficiently to prevent damage.
5. Campfires are not permitted on the site.

6. Noise should be kept to a reasonable level at all times so as not to disturb the enjoyment of others.

7. For everybody's comfort on site, pet owners are respectfully asked to ensure any mess is cleaned up and pet noise is kept to a minimum.

Sanitation

To provide the next guest with the same clean, tidy pitch as you found on arrival, please ensure that you dispose of any rubbish, wastewater and chemical waste in the designated areas before you depart. Rubbish should be recycled wherever possible. Never leave litter anywhere. If there aren't any suitable bins, please take your litter home with you.

Liability

You are responsible for keeping your belongings safe.

The Hall Committee cannot accept any responsibility for any loss or damage of personal belongings/equipment brought into the hall or to any vehicle or personal belongings left in the Hall car park or caravan park.

Check your pitch carefully before you leave to make sure you've not left anything behind, especially any litter.
